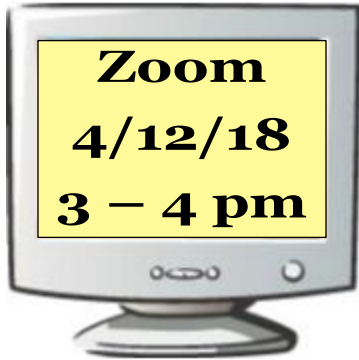

 Remember to make your praise behavior specific (using a verbal statement that names the behavior explicitly and includes a statement that shows approval). For example, "Blue Group, I really like the way you all handed in your projects on time. It was a complicated project" or walking over to a student and whispering, "Thank you for coming into the room quietly."
